Management of the nursing service at a hospital or at a nursing care institution:

This includes, in particular:

- Supervision, assurance and improvement of the quality of nursing and the organisation of nursing
- Management and deployment of nursing staff
- · Organisation of material resources and supervision of their use in the field of nursing
- Co-operation with other institutions, organisational units and professions

4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE (3)

In particular, employment by hospitals, institutions that specialise in the prevention, diagnosis or treatment of diseases or in follow-up care, care of disabled persons or in collecting blood or blood components or that offer other health and social services as well as authorities offering home nursing.

Pursuit of regulated professions on a self-employed basis:

Upon notification of the district administrative authority according to Art. 36 of the *Gesundheits- und Krankenpflegegesetz (GuKG*; Health Care and Nursing Act), nurses are entitled to work on a self-employed basis.
