Entry requirements: Diploma in nursing; admission test or interview.

In agreement with the management of the specialised course, the institution organising it decides on admission.

**Duration of education:** 1,000 hours (7 months)

Theoretical instruction: 500 hours

<u>Subjects</u>: Specialised nursing in the field of surgery; planning and organisation in the field of surgery; basic nursing research; communication and ethics; hygiene; medical technology; surgical anatomy; general surgical disciplines; specialised surgical disciplines; basic anaesthesia and pharmacology

Practical training: 500 hours at specialised departments of a hospital

#### Education objectives:

Acquisition of knowledge and skills for taking over and performing all activities required for fulfilling the relevant specialised tasks.
